EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

1.0 PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 To seek members approval to amend the Council's hackney carriage fares. A copy of the proposed revised fare table is attached at **Appendix A**.

2.0 RECOMMENDATION

- 2.1 It is recommended that:-
 - (i) The report be received
 - (ii) Members approve the revised table of fares

3.0 REASON FOR RECOMMENDATION

3.1 The last fare increase was approved over 8 years ago in November 2011. In light of this it is proposed to increase certain fares and amend the structure of the fare table, to align with the current costs of operating hackney carriages and reflect reasonable charges to the users of the service.

4.0 SIGNIFICANT RISK

4.1 There is a risk to the reputation of the Council for failure to set an appropriate table of hackney carriage fares.

5.0 POLICY CONTEXT & CONSULTATION

- 5.1 A document setting out the Council's proposals was issued to all hackney carriage proprietors earlier in the year to determine the level of support for the proposals together with any comments or observations proprietors may have.
- 5.2 Favourable support was received and all comments and observations were considered which resulted in additional amendments to the fare table in respect of where additional passengers are carried.

REPORT

6.0 REPORT DETAILS

- 6.1 Section 65 of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976 makes provision for the Council to fix the rates of fares for time, distance and all other charges in connection with the hire of a hackney carriage.
- When setting the fares the legislation does not prevent the Council from taking into account any external factors, and there is no limit on the amount of increase or variation (subject to reasonableness).
- 6.3 As the Council would like to encourage the provision of high quality hackney carriage vehicles it is important that fares are balanced, thereby ensuring proprietors are able to support the running costs associated with the high standard of vehicles required by the Council, but at the same time the fare should not be so high as to preclude use by passengers.
- 6.4 The current fare structure consists of 3 tariffs based on distance travelled and the time taken, including a standard day rate, a night time rate and rate reserved for Christmas Eve, New Year's Eve and all Bank Holidays.
- 6.5 Members are asked to consider the following amendments to these tariffs:
 - a) Increase the subsequent distance travelled under tariff 1 from 1/18th mile (97.8yds) to 1/20th mile (88yds).
 - b) Increase the charge for subsequent distance travelled from 22p to 25p (tariff 2) and from 27p to 30p (tariff 3).
 - c) To introduce an additional charge of £1.50 per passenger where more than 2 passengers are carried.
 - d) To clarify the extra charges which may be applied and to incorporate these within the fare card.
- 6.6 Clearly there are a number of factors which influence the costs of operating a hackney carriage such as insurance and fuel costs together with the general costs of living.
- As would be expected the fares set by local authorities vary from area to area. To enable Members to put Ryedale's current and proposed fares into context, an extract from the September 2019 issue of Private Hire and Taxi Monthly Magazine is attached at **Appendix B**. This extract includes the fares for local authorities in England, Scotland and Wales. Ryedale, together with a number of nearby local authorities are highlighted. For comparison if the proposed fare increase were to be approved, a 2 mile journey on tariff 1 would amount to £6.00. The current national average for this journey is £5.92 (Source: PHTM September 2019).
- 6.8 The revised fares would result in relatively small monetary increases to the cost of all journeys undertaken in the District which are considered to be both reasonable and proportionate given there have been no increases to the fares for 8 years.

7.0 IMPLICATIONS

7.1 The following implications have been identified:

a) Financial

If approved the Council must advertise the proposed fare increase in a local newspaper which can be accommodated within existing service budgets. There are no other implications on the Councils revenue budget associated with the proposed fare increase as the fare income is retained by the proprietor of the hackney carriage.

b) Legal

Legal implications are contained within the body of the report.

c) Equalities

It is recognised that Hackney Carriages form an important part of the local transport infrastructure. Fares must therefore be balanced to ensure proprietors are able to support the running costs associated with the high standard of vehicles required by the Council, but at the same time fares should not be so high as to preclude use by passengers.

d) Others

Other implications (Climate Change, Staffing, Planning, Health & Safety, Environmental, Crime & Disorder, Data Privacy) have been considered and do not apply.

8.0 NEXT STEPS

- 8.1 If approved by the Licensing Committee, the new proposed fare table will be subject to public consultation for a minimum of 14 days. If no objections are received it is intended to introduce the new fares from 13 January 2020.
- 8.2 If objections are received a further date shall be set (not later than two months from the first specified date), at which time the table of fares shall come into force with or without modifications as determined by the Licensing Committee after consideration of the objections.


