Due to the increased pieces of equipment, it has become increasingly difficult for our volunteers to cut the grass with the ride on mower around the equipment and hard to reach areas of the large site. The purchase of a petrol hover mower will assist volunteers with the labour intensive role of grass cutting from April through to October. The mower would enable two volunteers to work at the same time and get the job done while the weather is dry. A lot of the equipment volunteers are using is second hand and in need of replacement. We want to make this a sustainable and viable community facility which can be maintained at low cost by volunteers as apposed to employing expensive contractors. The play area is well used by all age groups and an fantastic asset to our village.

Why is the project needed?

Swinton is an active and lively village and we are determined to ensure that adequate community facilities are available to meet the needs of our growing population. The play area is maintained by volunteers, often using second hand equipment, the grass cutting is a large part of the workload from April through to October. Due to the hard work of the committee fund raising and improving facilities on the site, the grass cutting has become a challenge for the ride on mower getting round all the new equipment. Volunteers have been consulted and agreed that a petrol hover mower would speed up the grass cutting and able the task to be carried out by more than one volunteer at a time. The work on site is labour intensive, the equipment will assist with the grass cutting process and speed up the work involved to ensure the facility looks its best at all times of the year for our users.

Swinton Play Area Committee meet on a monthly basis to work through a plan of improvements to our wonderful facility. The purchase of a mower was an agreed way forward to assist the work carried out by all the hard working volunteers who constantly strive to make the village a lovely place for people to enjoy, work and live.

A key measure will be the extent to which we have retained our current volunteers and recruited new ones. Feedback from volunteers will be obtained following the purchase of the new equipment.

The obesity levels in Ryedale are higher than average, therefore, providing a free outdoor facility that meets the needs expressed by our local residents providing the opportunity to participate in an physical activity.
