It is placed lower on the plot making it less visible from the west and will be shielded by trees. It will be visible from the east but it is clad with wood and stone. The installation of drainage to stop water running onto the road is a good addition. The access needed hard standing to be of any use at all. One Councillor felt it should be reduced further in height.

The decision of the council is to approve these plans. It is a farming area and farmers need buildings for their stock and feed.
