

LOCAL GOVERNMENT AND PUBLIC INVOLVEMENT IN HEALTH ACT 2007

The Ryedale District Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2019

Coming into force in accordance with article 1(2)

Ryedale District Council (“the council”), in accordance with section [82(a)] of the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007 (“the 2007 Act”), has undertaken a community governance review and made recommendations dated [month] [year]:

The council has decided to give effect to those recommendations and, in accordance with section 93 of the 2007 Act, has consulted with the local government electors and other interested persons and has had regard to the need to secure that community governance reflects the identities and interests of the community and is effective and convenient:

The council, in accordance with section 100 of the 2007 Act, has had regard to guidance issued under that section:

The council makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 86 [98(3)][, 98(4)][, 98(6)] and 240(10) of the 2007 Act.

Citation and commencement(a)

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Ryedale District Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2019

(2) [It shall come into force on [any date] [the day after that on which it is made]].

Interpretation

2. In this Order—

“district” means the district of Ryedale Council;

“ordinary day of election of councillors” has the meaning given by section 37 of the Representation of the People Act 1983.

Effect of Order

3. This Order has effect subject to any agreement under section 99 (agreements about incidental matters) of the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007 relevant to any provision of this Order.

Election[s] for the parish of Malton

(i) The number of councillors for the parish of Malton are increased from 10 to 12 councillors, with effect from the May 2019 ordinary elections.

(ii) Where any provision of an Order made before the making of this Order requires an election of parish councillors for a parish mentioned in paragraphs (i) above to be held on a date other than that

for which paragraph(i) provides, it shall cease to have effect to that extent.

Order date

22. 1st March is the order date for the purposes of the Local Government (Parishes and Parish Councils) (England) Regulations 2008.
