- Proposed domestic courtyard: mix of soft and hard landscape
- Proposed access roads: tarmac
- Tar spray and chip finish as used at Castle Howard
- Soldier course of setts with cobble walk
- Setts delineation across road
- Proposed high wall materials as shown
- Proposed brick wall 1.0-1.2m high with stone coping
- Estate fencing with matching double, field or single gate as shown
- Proposed & existing timber post & rail fencing with matching double, field or single gate as shown
