SUBJECT: **FOR INFORMATION – Cycle Stands**
WARDS AFFECTED: Market Towns, Thornton Dale

1.0 Background

- 1.1 A report was considered by Members at the December 2007 Policy & Resources Committee seeking a view on the provision of cycle stands in market towns. The report offered three options for Members to consider:
- a) engage with the process of NYCC Service Centre Transportation Strategies (SCTS) which would look at provision;
 - b) provide stands on the areas under district control; or
 - c) take no action.
- 1.2 Members were of the view that rather than Ryedale District Council making provision at the current time on land in its ownership, instead it engages with the SCTS process.

2.0 Update

- 2.1 Consultation on the SCTSs is ongoing however the most recent update is provided for Members information:
- 2.2 Helmsley – issues have arisen with various stakeholders in relation to street furniture. NYCC has indicated that this can be re-visited.
- 2.3 Kirkbymoorside - cycle rack to be provided in Market Place near benches that have been provided by the Town Council.
- 2.4 Pickering - cycle racks exist at the bottom of the Market Place. More can be provided if demand is demonstrated.
- 2.5 Malton - cycle racks exist in the Market Place (provided by Ryedale). More can be provided if demand is demonstrated.
- 2.6 Norton - two racks to be provided as part of the Commercial Street improvements.
- 2.7 Thornton Dale - provided rack near the pedestrian crossing on the A170.
- 2.8 It should be noted that any reference to racks implies simple racks and not cycle shelters. These are provided by the highway authority.
