To enable the provision of Affordable housing for Rent and low cost Ownership for sale

- Agreement in principle with local landowner to develop scheme to convert property to provide five units of affordable housing
- Follow-up review of progress as a result of the Affordable Housing Review which took place in 2006 by the Audit Commission
- Completion of 45 affordable properties between April and September 2008
- Held a successful Open Day to promote the affordable housing scheme in Nawton / Beadlam
- Meeting of the Affordable Housing Project Group
- Held a meeting of the Ryedale Housing Forum
