Councillor Mrs Arnold declared an interest as a North Yorkshire County Councillor.

LS.78 **To determine an application for a variation to a Premises Licence from Holf Leisure Ltd for the Royal Oak, Main Street, Gillamoor, YO62 7HX**

The Chairman welcomed all representatives to the meeting and appropriate introductions were made.

The Chairman explained that the hearing was subject to the prescribed procedure, copies of which had been circulated with the agenda. Representatives were reminded that opening statements were to be brief as all parties had had the opportunity to make detailed written submissions and to consider the submissions of other parties. The Chairman also advised those present that additional information produced at the hearing without prior disclosure may not be heard if, following objections to its submission, the Sub-Committee so determined.

The Chairman also reminded those present that their representations should be relevant to the licensing objectives under the Licensing Act 2003, namely:

- The prevention of crime and disorder
- Public safety
- The prevention of public nuisance
- The protection of children from harm

The Council's Licensing Officer then presented the report which had been circulated with the agenda and referred to the relevant points contained in the guidance.

An application had been received for a variation to a Premises Licence for the

Royal Oak, Main Street, Gillamoor, York, YO62 7HX.

Details of the Proposal

- To extend the hours for the sale by retail of alcohol until 00:00 hours each day and on New Years Eve from the end of permitted hours on New Years Eve to the start of permitted hours on the following day.
- Provision of Late Night Refreshment each day between the hours of 23:00 and 00:00.

All responsible Authorities had been consulted and the Licensing Authority had received relevant representations from:

- Two interested party on the Prevention of Public Nuisance Licensing Objective

The interested parties appeared to be mainly concerned with potential noise disturbance.

Representatives put their respective cases to the Sub Committee Members.

Members noted that they had taken into account the letters received from the interested parties.

Following questions from Members the representatives summed up their cases prior to the Committee retiring to consider the application, after which the following decision was announced:

Resolved

That the application for a variation for a Premises Licence from Holf Leisure Ltd for the Royal Oak, Main Street, Gillamoor be granted as per the application:

- Supply of alcohol from 10:00 hours until 00:00 hours each day of the week
- Premises open to the public 10:00 hours until 00:30 hours
- Late night refreshment from 23:00 hours to 00:00
- Conditions 3, 4 and 5 of Annex 1 of the premises licence be removed
