WITH REGARD TO THE PARISH COUNCIL MEETING ARRANGED FOR THE 4TH MAY, THIS WILL NOT BE HELD BUT, AFTER CONSULTATION WITH COUNCILLORS, MAINLY BY EMAIL, TRUNCATED MINUTES WILL BE PREPARED. THESE WILL BE CIRCULATED TO COUNCILLORS, POSTED ONLINE ON THE RYEDALE DISTRICT COUNCIL WEBSITE AND ON THE NOTICE BOARD.

2.VOTE OF THANKS FOR THE NATIONAL HEALTH SERVICE, CARERS AND THE EMERGENCY SERVICES, ESPECIALLY THOSE WHO LIVE IN BYLAND, WASS AND OLDSTEAD, WHOSE WORK ENSURES THAT PEOPLE STAY AS SAFE AS POSSIBLE.
