- Cyperus cyparissia laylandii** - Is used as a planting plant for its ever-green screen of the great green foliage. From the center, the red plants will create a vertical screen that will create a sense of enclosure and privacy. It is also used as an effective wind-breaker.
- Field maple campestre** - Grows more than 10m away from any building. It is a compact, rounded tree with attractive 5-lobed leaves that turn a rich golden yellow in autumn. It is a natural acrobatic that they called 'horsetail tree'.
- Prunella verticillata** - A small, upright shrub with delicate yellow flowers. Can be planted at the foot of a hedge or on a border and planted out in the autumn.
- Rosa rugosa** - The 'bobby's rose' is a hardy little mountain ash tree with soft, delicate, non-pruned leaves. They provide an excellent source of shade in the summer. - Pyrus calleryana Chanticleer** - is an extremely popular deciduous tree which is often planted for screening purposes. The young tree is the first to come into leaf in the spring, when the leaves emerge in conjunction with a pale white flower which covers the tree. The foliage further emerges as a bright and glossy green and remains on the tree until well before falling, not only in Pyrus calleryana Chanticleer but in the other trees in the area. It is a useful quality for screening. It has a soft and pleasant appearance when young, gradually breaking to a more ornate shape as it matures.

- Lonicera periclymenum Belgica - Honey-suckle** - is a shrubby climber used by other groups for the deck, bearing fragrant, tubular white flowers, which mature to yellow, from July to September.
