**Planting Notes**

**Topsoil** Shall be a minimum of 400mm depth over staking beds and graded to fall. Import based must be BS3882 2007 compliant and existing topsoil must be cultivated in accordance with BS3882 2007. No cultivation shall be done in wet weather conditions.

**Herbicide and copperfate:** Must be applied with two applications of herbicide prior to planting, where necessary. Apply in accordance with the Control of Pesticides Regulations 2009 (see attached '0709' or '0809' attached) or read and follow manufacturer's instructions by supplier and the topsoil shall be cultivated to 10cm depth.

**Planting:** All planting and laying shall comply to BS 308: 1992 and BS 4423 1986.

**Trees:** Shall not be planted in the immediate vicinity of structures or drainage of roads, wherever is greater. Trees to be supported by 'W' stakes (1500mm long per tree, 300mm above ground. 750mm diameter) and 'W' shall be supported to: Trees to be planted centrally with a tree pit. Trees planted within pits to have for drainage - ground level not over 100mm depth. Any trees of old or chemical means.

**Water:** Must not be watered immediately after installation or in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions.

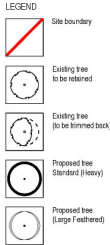
**Plant protection:** All trees to be protected by 1500mm adjacent pavement and other surfaces to prevent spillage.

**Plant position:** Final position of trees and shrubs subject to confirmation of site location and approval of statutory authorities.

**Protection to planting:** Name tags and similar markers must be to be constructed by similar means as used by Acorn Planting Products Ltd (01505 530878), or equivalent.

**Work:** All surfaces to be cultivated and levelled as required removing any stones, roots, cables, general construction waste.

**Planting Season:** Bare root plants to be planted between mid-November and mid-March dependent upon the planting location.
