Further to the parish council's formal objection (see below) sent on 23th December 2022.

I have been instructed by the parish council to send the attached supplementary information as part of our submission in objecting to this planning application. There is also a newspaper extract attached referring to a similar occurrence in another part of the country which at face value appears to have some similar charactrics with this application, and the article also makes reference to the Prime Ministers views on matters such as this. Many local residents have expressed their concerns to the parish councillors about this building and its actual intended usage.

Given the nature of the business currently being operated at this location, the following legal requirements should be investigated to ensure that the owner is compliant with current legalisation:-

- 1. Is he registered with the Animal Health and Veterinary Agency? This means the owner is subject to inspections, for which there will be a record.
- 2. The owner should be registered in accordance with the Animal Feed Regulations.
- 3. The owner should be registered with the Environmental Agency.
- 4. Does he have a Water Extraction Certificate?

There are also issues with animal waste disposal and potential contamination of local water courses which need to be considered. The parish council trusts that the planning committee will take account of local resident's and the parish council's objections to this application.
