

| Housing to service redetermine tourism so Housing trestructures | 22-Jun-2011 The One-11 voluntary redundancy programme has resulted in four members of staff leaving the Economy and Housing teams. In Economy this covered staff dealing with the industrial letting and tourism services. This has resulted in a service review of the industrial letting service involving E&C, Asset management, finance, legal and transformation to determine the various options of how to undertake this service. In addition, the Commissioning Board has since reviewed the tourism service and agreed the most effective delivery mechanism given current industry needs and resources. Within Housing the Unit Manager and Senior Tech Officer left and a Service review was then undertaken and the Unit has been restructured.
